- **Oct. 25, 2011:** Completed HD mustard ton container campaign and chemical demilitarization operations.
- **Oct. 20, 2011:** Last HD ton container (TC) transported from depot storage to disposal plant
- **June 11, 2009:** Began first HDTC destruction in the Metal Parts Furnace (MPF).
- **June 4, 2009:** First HD TCs transported from depot storage to disposal plant.
- **Nov. 5, 2008:** Completed VX munitions campaign.
- **Oct. 26, 2007:** Began VX munitions campaign.
- **July 8, 2007:** Completed GB munitions campaign.
- **Sept. 7, 2004:** Began GB munitions campaign.
