## Umatilla Accomplishments

### UMCDF chemical disposal operations to date:

- 2,500 GB-filled rockets have been destroyed.
- Some 20,845 pounds of agent have been destroyed.
- One storage igloo has been completely emptied.

- Rocket processing resumed Dec. 23, 2004.
- Implemented slow, deliberate and safe startup.
