UMCDF Update

- "Parallel" processing of rockets and chemical agent simultaneously has begun.
- Rocket processing was limited to three days due to a maintenance outage on the Deactivation Furnace System.
- Long-term corrective actions from the December safety stand down are being completed.
- Safely protecting all depot workers, the general public and the environment remain the depot's top priorities.
- Precision and proficiency vs. production are the focus for our people, plant and procedures.
