## PBCDF Operations

### Chemical Weapons Eliminated:

- Weekly Total: **742** Nerve Agent GB Rockets
- Project Total: **12,911** Nerve Agent GB Rockets

### Nerve Agent GB Eliminated (Liquid Incinerator):

- Weekly Total: **6,470** pounds
- Project Total: **117,744** pounds



Deactivation Furnace

**Tue, 6/28:** Eliminated 298 GB rockets and 3,556 pounds of GB  
**Wed, 6/29:** Eliminated 261 GB rockets and 1,394 pounds of GB  
**Thu, 6/30:** Eliminated 183 GB rockets and 894 pounds of GB  
**Fri, 7/01:** Eliminated 0 GB rockets and 626 pounds of GB  
**Sat, 7/02:** Eliminated 0 GB rockets and 0 pounds of GB  
**Sun, 7/03:** Eliminated 0 GB rockets and 0 pounds of GB  
**Mon, 7/04:** Eliminated 0 GB rockets and 0 pounds of GB

Rocket processing was not conducted Friday through Monday in order to conduct maintenance activities. PBCDF conducted practice agent trial burns (often known as "mini-burns") for the Deactivation Furnace Tuesday through Thursday. Agent trial burns are conducted to measure the environmental performance of the furnace systems. The Deactivation Furnace is the first system being assessed and will be followed by the Liquid Incinerator.
