Rockets were not processed Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday in order to conduct maintenance on the heated discharge conveyor (HDC). The HDC is the area where rocket debris is placed after exiting the Deactivation Furnace. Rockets were not processed Saturday and Monday in order to conduct additional personnel training. The additional training was conducted after determination of a badge procedure error.
