### UMCDF Update.

- A fire occurred at 9:16 p.m. Friday, July 28, on the ECR-B line, temporarily suspending operations. The fire started in an M55 GB sarin rockets' motor section as the rocket shear machine was making the fifth of seven cuts. ECR-A line was undergoing routine maintenance and resumed operations at 5 p.m. Saturday. ECR-B was back on-line at 3 a.m. Sunday.

- The depot's four non-stockpile GB ton containers were moved from storage to the UMCDF, completing phase 1 of this campaign.

- UMCDF employees have worked over 1.2 million safe work hours without a lost workday.
