UMCDF Operations

- Safety is number one at UMCDF: employees have worked 544 days since the last lost-workday accident (Oct. 22, 2004).
- Munitions and chemical agent processing were not conducted through April 18, due to fire damper testing and a jam in the Deactivation Furnace System (DFS) Heated Discharge Conveyor (HDC). Rocket processing resumed on April 19.
- Repairs completed to the HDC chain..
