

TOCDF Update

- The Tooele Chemical Agent Disposal Facility (TOCDF) began mustard agent operations on Aug. 18, signaling the beginning of the last major destruction campaign at the U.S. Army's TOCDF at Deseret Chemical Depot (DCD).
As of Sept. 18, facility workers have safely disposed of 32 ton containers, representing .44% of DCD's mustard agent stockpile.

Other News:

- On Sept. 13, the annual full-scale Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP) exercise took place. DCD joined several local, state and federal agencies to exercise response efforts to a chemical and other non-chemical emergencies. The event began with a mock accident in the DCD storage area and included other incidents in the surrounding areas.
