





- Nov. 6, 2006: Processed the 100,000th munition stockpiled at Umatilla.
- Nov. 5, 2006: Surpassed 800 tons of chemical agent destroyed.
- Sept. 28, 2006: Began GB M426 8-inch projectile campaign.
- Aug. 9, 2006: Completed GB M55 rocket campaign.
