

### TOCDF Feed Rate Increase

The Tooele Chemical Agent Disposal Facility (TOCDF) recently received approval from the Utah Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste and Department of Air Quality to increase the feed to the Metal Parts Furnace (MPF). The feed rate was increased to 100 percent of that demonstrated during the trial burn. TOCDF, with full support from Utah State agencies, has achieved 100% feed rate in the MPF in only 88 days following completion of the trial burn. Approval of the MPF 100% feed rate supports the schedule to achieve the 45% Treaty milestone.

### Mustard Agent Detected in Storage Igloo at DCD

On April 12, trace amount of mustard agent (less than 1 ml) leaking from the plug of a bulk container was discovered during routine movement operations in the storage area of Deseret Chemical Depot.

Depot workers in protective clothing used specialized equipment to contain the vapor, then moved the agent-filled munition to a storage structure where they removed the crystallized agent residue from the outside of the container and replaced the plugs/valves.

Tooele county officials were notified and there was no danger to surrounding communities.
