Multiple Round Container

Upon discovery of suspect recovered chemical warfare materiel (RCWM), the U.S. Army Non-Stockpile Chemical Materiel Project (NSCMP) dispatches the Mobile Munition Assessment System to identify the liquid fill within a suspect item and determine its explosive configuration. The suspect item is then placed into a Multiple Round Container (MRC) for safe storage and possible transport to await final disposition.

MRC

MRCs are a family of six different over-pack containers designed to allow the safe storage and transport of RCWM. MRCs contain chemical agent leaks, aiding in the protection of their contents during accidents or rough handling.

MRCs were specifically designed, tested and fielded for the transport of chemical warfare materiel and exceed international packaging requirements. MRCs are also approved by the Department of Defense and Department of Transportation for the storage and transportation of RCWM in the public domain.



Multiple Round Containers are a family of over-pack containers designed to allow the safe storage and transport of recovered chemical warfare materiel.
