Pueblo Chemical Depot

Lieutenant Colonel Timothy M. Greenhaw *Pueblo Chemical Depot Commander*

Lt. Col. Timothy M. Greenhaw graduated from Bowling Green State University, Bowling Green, Ohio, with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Environment Policy and Analysis and was commissioned an officer in the United States Army Chemical Corps in 1992. He received his Master of Science Degree in Administration from the Central Michigan University in 2004.

Lt. Col Greenhaw's military education includes Airborne, Air Assault, the Chemical Officer Basic Course, the Chemical Officer Advance, the Combined Arms and Services Staff School, Jumpmaster and the Command General Staff College.

Prior to his selection by the Headquarters, Department of the Army Centrally Select List (HQDA CSL) to serve as a Battalion Level Commander, Lt. Col. Greenhaw was assigned as the Executive Officer to the Commanding General, 8th Army/Chief of Staff, United Nations Command/Combined Forces Command/United States Forces Korea (UNC/CFC/USFK).

Lt. Col. Greenhaw began his military assignment as a Battalion Chemical Officer initially in Korea before his reassignment to Schofield Barracks, Hawaii. Greenhaw then served as a Platoon Leader before serving as a Division Artillery Chemical Officer for the 82nd Airborne Division, Fort Bragg. He was assigned as Commander of the 21st Chemical Company Smoke/Decon (Airborne) before becoming a Battalion Operations Officer while assigned to the 472nd Chemical Battalion in Chicago, Illinois. Greenhaw served as 82nd Airborne Division Deputy Chemical Officer before he became a Division G3 Training and Operations Officer before moving on to becoming Battalion S3 and Executive Officer for the 4th Infantry Brigade, 82nd Airborne Division. While still at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, he served as the 18th Airborne Corps Anti-Terrorism/Force Protection Operations Officer before he was deployed to Iraq for a year. Upon his return to CONUS, he was assigned as



the Corps CBRN Operations Officer for the 18th Airborne Corps. This assignment was immediately followed by his OCONUS assignment to Yongsan, Korea as the 8th Army CBRN Officer; followed by his assignment as Executive Officer to the Commanding General, 8th Army/Chief of Staff, UNC/CFC/USFK, Yongsan, Korea, until his selection by HQDA CSL.

Lt. Col. Greenhaw's awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (1st Oak Leaf Cluster), Army Commendation Medal (2nd Oak Leaf Cluster), Army Achievement Medal (1st Oak Leaf Cluster), the Joint Meritorious Unit Award, National Defense Service Medal (2nd Award), ICMCS, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Korean Defense Service Medal, the Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon, the Air Assault and Senior Parachutist Badge.
