


Lt.Col. Flucker, ANCA completes prime chemical munitions task



The Anniston Chemical Activity commander and his team were responsible for safely moving chemical munitions to the Anniston Chemical Agent Disposal Facility for destruction. They no longer store any nerve agent or mustard agent munitions. (Guthrie)

Key Messages

- ◆ The Anniston chemical munitions were safely maintained and moved by Anniston Chemical Activity employees under the command of Lt.Col. Willie J. Flucker.
- ◆ The last chemical munitions in Anniston, Ala., were safely destroyed on September 22, 2011.
- ◆ Since 1990, more than 25,245 tons of chemicals and more than 2,556,060 munitions have been safely incinerated at U.S. Army facilities.

The Anniston Chemical Agent Disposal Facility (ANCDF) team completed its chemical munitions destruction mission on September 22, 2011. (Creed)

Anniston Milestones

- ◆ **September 22, 2011:** ANCDF chemical munitions destruction operations conclude.
- ◆ **July 2, 2009 ~ September 22, 2011:** All **299,727** mustard agent munitions and **181,856** gallons of mustard agent are safely demilitarized.
- ◆ **September 8, 2011:** Anniston Chemical Activity ends its munitions storage mission.
- ◆ **July 23, 2006 ~ December 24, 2008:** All **219,374** VX agent munitions and **196,925** gallons of VX nerve agent are safely demilitarized.
- ◆ **August 9, 2003 ~ March 2, 2006:** All **142,428** GB munitions and **96,078** gallons of GB nerve agent are safely demilitarized.
- ◆ **1997 ~ 2003:** Westinghouse Anniston constructs and tests the ANCDF.
- ◆ **1963:** Anniston Army Depot begins chemical munitions storage mission.
